## Trustees

### **Peter Boone** **Executive Chair**

Peter Boone is the Chair of Effective Intervention. From 1997-2003 he was a Managing Partner and Research Director for Brunswick-UBS, an investment bank in Moscow. From 1993-1997 he was a lecturer at the London School of Economics and Director of the Emerging Markets Finance Programme at the CEP. He completed a Ph.D. in economics from Harvard University in 1990.

### **Amy Boone** **Director**

Amy Boone is a Director of Effective Intervention. She taught American politics at Moscow State University from 1998-2000 and also ran the Ohlin Institute Moscow Programme at the Russian Diplomatic Academy. From 1989-1994 she served as a diplomat in Nigeria, Germany, Ukraine and Russia. From 1986 to 1989 she was a programme officer for the Bradley Foundation, where she was responsible for evaluating and selecting projects to be funded. She studied at Harvard University in the Ph.D. program in government and at the University of Chicago in undergraduate studies.

### **Brigitte Granville** **Director**

Brigitte Granville is a Director of Effective Intervention. She is a Professor of International Economics and Economic Policy at Queen Mary's University and a Fellow of the Centre for Globalisation Research. From 1998-2003 she ran the International Economics Program at Chatham House, and founded their programme on essential medicines. She has edited two books on Essential Medicines and has travelled throughout Asia and Africa as a consultant on related issues. She has published many articles and written books related to monetary economics, particularly in formerly socialist countries.
